Concord, Macintosh Version

To accommodate users whose equipment is not compatible with the low-density diskette format, we also include in this package Concord for the Macintosh on CD-ROM. This CD contains exactly the same program as the diskettes, and is easier and quicker to install.

To Install Mac concord from the CD-ROM:

From the open Mac CD folder, drag the folder named "Concord" to your hard disk's icon. The folder "Concord" will be copied to your hard drive.

To use Concord:

Open your hard drive, then open the folder "Concord" on your hard drive. Double-click the program icon "Concord". A large color "splash screen" will briefly appear to indicate that the program is starting, and then the concord menu bar will appear. Pull down the "books" menu and begin using Concord. The Tutorial Chapter and the Quick Reference Guide will help you get started.

Setting the Sound Player to play hymns on your Mac:

Concord 1.2b enables the hymn Player to work correctly on all Macintosh models. Previously, it could not play hymns on Power PC or AV models. A new Sound Booster eliminates certain problems experienced on the Mac Plus, SE and LC with System 7.

1. On the menu bar in Concord, Pull down the citations menu and choose "Play Hymn" (or Cmd-H).
2. Click on the Sound pop-up menu, move down and select "Boost".
3. Change Sound Booster settings as follows:
 - Power Sound-- Check for Quadras, Power PCs (including G3s) and AV Macs. If hymns do not play at all, change this setting.
 - Stutter Control-- Check only if stuttering or note skipping occurs.
 - To close window, click the close box in the upper left; do not use the default button.
4. Click the play button to hear your hymns.

Note: The booster cannot be adjusted while hymns are playing or trying to play; click "Stop"; then adjust.
